DETAILS


Pick up sample containers on Friday October 3rd from 8AM-5PM at the Lima Town Hall.


Sampling is simple and takes roughly 15 minutes.

Tests for: Coliform Bacteria, Nitrate, pH, Chloride, Hardness, Alkalinity, Conductivity, Saturation Index

Metals - \$50

Tests for: Arsenic, Lead, Copper, Iron, Zinc, Calcium, Magnesium, Manganese, Sodium, Potassium, Sulfate

DACT Screen - \$35

Tests for: a breakdown component of Atrazine type pesticides

Cost for all three - \$125
