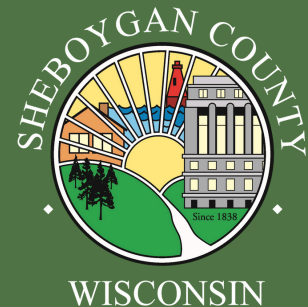

## THREE TESTING PACKAGES



### Homeowners - \$40

Tests for: Coliform Bacteria, Nitrate, pH, Chloride, Hardness, Alkalinity, Conductivity, Saturation Index

### Metals - \$50

Tests for: Arsenic, Lead, Copper, Iron, Zinc, Calcium, Magnesium, Manganese, Sodium, Potassium, Sulfate

### DACT Screen - \$35

Tests for: a breakdown component of Atrazine type pesticides

### Cost for all three - \$125
