Hours of operation: **Saturday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM year round**

Additional summer hours: Wednesday 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM
from Memorial Day through Labor Day

Non-Hang Tag owners: All garbage must be separated from the recyclable materials and placed in Town of Lima yellow 33 gallon plastic bags; recyclables in clear plastic bags, bins, or totes - if clear plastic bags are used, they need to be dumped out with bags then placed in garbage compactor.

Hang Tag owners: All garbage must be separated from the recyclable materials and placed in any size/color (**no black**) plastic bags; recyclables in clear plastic bags, bins, or totes – if clear plastic bags are used, they need to be dumped out with bags then placed in garbage compactor. Owners of current and valid Hang Tags are not required to purchase Town of Lima bags. To gain entrance to the Compactor Site, valid Hang Tags must be made visible, or presented to the Site Attendants.

Town of Lima yellow bags and clear bags are sold at the site. All bags are 33 gallon plastic bags. Clear bags cost \$40 for 100 bags/case. Yellow bags cost \$40 for 25 bags/sleeve. Payment by check only - made payable to the Town of Lima. No cash payments accepted.

Hang tag disposal permits expire on August 1 each year. Original Hang Tags and annual renewal stickers can be obtained by **mailing a check for \$200 payable to the Town of Lima** along with a self-addressed stamped envelope to PO Box 225, Waldo, WI 53093-0225. Recyclable materials shall include the items listed below prepared as follows – whether you have a hang tag disposal permit or not:

Mixed together in a clear plastic bag, bin, or tote. Plastic bag, if used, needs to be emptied then placed in garbage compactor:

- Glass – rinsed, caps removed
- Bi-metal “tin” cans – rinsed
- Aluminum cans – rinsed
- Plastics #1 thru #7 - rinsed

Mixed together in a paper grocery bag, bin, tote, or clear plastic bag. Plastic bag, if used, needs to be emptied then placed in garbage compactor:

- Cardboard
- Magazines
- Newsprint
- Office Paper
- All other paperboard products such as boxes from cereal, cake or other food mixes, soda or beer, etc.
- No shredded paper that is garbage

NOT ACCEPTED

Asphalt, asphalt shingles, cement, plaster, bricks or rocks, compost, garden waste, brush, wood, stumps, dead animals, asbestos, ballasts, capacitors, tires, waste oil, cars or other vehicles, car engines, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, dishwashers, mattresses or box springs, furniture, computers and all computer components, any item containing mercury, and any other materials considered hazardous waste by the EPA.

No loose ashes accepted – must be in tied plastic bag – burning barrels containing loose ash will not be accepted – barrels must be empty.
